Basic Steps

Read through the BASIC STEPS before you start!

Step 1. You will need an adult to help you download, print out the workbook, and help you with cutting the templates.

Step 2. Watch the video!

Step 3. Gather your supplies and work through the practice pages on scrap paper.

TO FINISH:

Step 4. On your good piece of paper (a little heavier)

lightly sketch your letters.

Step 5. Add your features and then erase all the lines you DON'T want.

Step 6. Using the black permanent marker, go over all of your pencil lines.

Step 7. Now you can colour!

Supplies and Tips

*Washable markers work great beacuse they dont seep through the paper and they dont smudge the black outline.

*A nice black marker will really make your artwork pop! Not too thin...


*If you want to frame your artwork, consider painting an inexpensive frame to match your drawing. Just use ordinary craft paint.

*Using a heavier paper is easier to erase on and nicer with markers.

Extras: fine black marker, white gel pen, white chalk marker, glitter, metalic markers,

PARTS OF A LETTER

Every letter is made up of 5 basic parts!



The shapes shown above would make 'block' letters, like this:




COMIC CRAZE SMALL TEMPLATE




MAKE SHADOWS BY DUPLICATING THE LETTER AND MOVING IT SLIGHTY DOWN AND TO ONE SIDE, THEN ERASE THE EXTRA LINES AND FILL IN WITH BLACK





IF YOU LOOK AT A COMIC BOOK CLOSELY, YOU WILL SEE THAT THE COLOURS ARE OFTEN MADE UP OF DOTS IN DIFFERENT SHAPES AND SIZES. THIS WAS HOW PRINTERS COULD EASILY AND CHEAPLY MAKE DIFFERENT SHADES AND SECONDARY COLOURS USING ONLY A FEW COLOURS OF INK. SO A YELLOW SHAPE FILLED WITH RED DOTS WOULD "APPEAR" TO BE ORANGE. YOU CAN BUY DOTTED STENCILS LIKE THIS AT CRAFT STORES OR YOU CAN FREEHAND THE DOTS!





IF YOU CUT THESE OUT OF HEAVY CARDSTOCK, YOU CAN MAKE A STENCIL




Start by finding the central letter of your word by counting. In this case it is the \bigcirc

Now, using your templates, outline your letters in pencil (lightly) . Dont be afraid to overlap

*We don't use
the stroke
shape too
much in comic
lettering, but
you can try it
if you like!

Now erase the pencil lines that are overlapping

*If it helps,
you can tape
the shapes
together to
form the
letters before
tracing

Next, using your black permanent marker, outline the letters.

Duplicate your letters using the templates...move them over and down a little bit to create the shadow. Shadows are super important in comic lettering! Fill in the shadows!

*We are almost ready for some colour!
